

KINESIOLOGY UNDERGRADUATE MAJOR APPLICATION

for progression as an upperclassman major and transition from College of EHHS Advising to advising with a KRSS department advisor

First, check your profile to determine if you are a uTrack student or not.

Directions for students NOT on uTrack:

Students who are not on uTrack must meet the following requirements to be eligible to apply for progression into the major.

1. Complete at least 45 semester hours with a minimum 2.50 cumulative UT GPA
2. Complete the required prerequisite courses with the appropriate grade:
 - a. Complete Kinesiology 100 with a grade of "C" or better
 - b. Pass Chemistry 120
 - c. Pass Physics 221
3. Meet the 75 hour rule:
 - a. Students must apply to the Kinesiology major prior to the completion of 75 hours of coursework from all institutions. Only completed hours count, not attempted.
 - b. Hours earned through AP credit or dual enrollment while in high school do not count toward this total.
 - c. Students who do not meet this rule may request a waiver of this rule by scheduling a meeting with Margy Wirtz-Henry (mwirtz@utk.edu)

Directions for students on uTrack:

Students on uTrack will transition from college to department advising upon completion of all requirements/uTrack milestones through Term 4 as listed in Kinesiology major showcase.

1. Meet all uTrack milestones up to Term 4:
 - a. Pass Math 125 or Math 141
 - b. Pass Chemistry 130
 - c. Pass Physics 221
 - d. Complete Kinesiology 100 with a grade of "C" or better
2. A minimum 2.50 cumulative UT GPA

For All Students:

- To apply to the Kinesiology major, you must fully complete the attached application and submit to Margy Wirtz-Henry in HPER 321B or via email to mwirtz@utk.edu.
- All requirements must show on your transcript at the time of application or you will be denied and have to reapply.
- Once the application is completed, turned in, and reviewed, and all requirements are met, students will be contacted via email regarding admission and assigned a KRSS department advisor.
- The student will then schedule an entrance advising meeting and transcript evaluation with their assigned KRSS department advisor.
- **Only after you have successfully completed this meeting will you be allowed to continue in the Kinesiology major and to register for Kinesiology majors-only classes.**
