Camp Koinonia

Frequently Asked Questions

Q) What is the cost for Camp Koinonia?

A) For 2022, the cost of Camp Koinonia will be \$460.00 per camper.

Q) Where is Camp Koinonia held?

A) Camp Koinonia is held at Clyde M. York, 4-H Training Center located in Crossville, Tennessee.

Q) When is Camp Koinonia?

A) The date for Camp Koinonia 2022 is set for Sunday, April 24th – Friday, April 29th.

Q) Is transportation provided?

A) Unfortunately, at this time, we do not have a way to provide transportation to camp. There are some circumstances where you may be able to carpool with another camper. Call our office for more information.

Q) What medical staff is present?

A) There is at least one Registered Nurse (RN) on site in the medical clinic at all times. All medical staff must be med certified as we are up-to-date on all licensing and certifications such as First Aid & CPR. University of Tennessee nursing students will help provide care and administer medications under the supervision of their clinical instructors.

Q) If we cannot afford the entire camp fee, can my child still attend?

A) A limited number of scholarships are available in order to defray some of the cost to attend Camp Koinonia. Call our staff for more information.

Q) Will I be able call my child while he/she is at camp?

A) Yes, during specific times. We ask that staff and campers stay off of their phones during the day, especially during activities, meals, and special events. This helps us to create the safest environment while still allowing time for parents and campers to communicate regularly.

Q) Will I get to meet my child's counselor before camp?

A) Absolutely! We hold a "Meet & Greet" on UTK's campus prior to camp and invite all campers and their families to attend. Emails are sent out to families a few weeks in advance indicating date, time, & exact location. This provides families and perspective campers the opportunity to meet not only the counselor, but also the entire cabin group interact as well as a few of the activities/games we do at camp.
